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Background

In October 2000, Maryland's Department of Health and Mental Hygiene implemented an annual licensure process for acute care hospitals based on inpatient census. This process standardized the measurement of licensed acute care hospital beds throughout the state. The Maryland Health Care Commission calculates the average daily census of each hospital for a 12 month reporting period, and licensed bed capacity is established for the next fiscal year at 140% of the hospital's average daily census. This licensure approach implies an optimal average annual occupancy rate of approximately 71.4% for all hospitals.

The initial implementation of this licensure process resulted in a statewide reduction in licensed acute care hospital bed capacity of 2,773 beds. The total licensed acute care beds have increased each year since the system went into effect in 2001. The increase in total licensed beds ranges from a low of a less than 1% increase from FY 2005 to FY 2006 to a high of 2.5% between FY 2004 and FY 2005. For FY 2008, there was an increase of 2.4% in total licensed beds..

This *Annual Report on Maryland Acute Care Hospital Services and Licensed Bed Capacity: Fiscal Year 2008* has been prepared by the Maryland Health Care Commission's Center for Hospital Services. Licensed acute general hospital beds (medical/surgical/gynecology/addictions [MSGA], obstetric, pediatric and acute psychiatric services) are included in this inventory report. Newborn bassinets and non-acute care beds located in acute care hospitals, such as "special hospital" beds (rehabilitation, chronic care, long term psychiatric services) are excluded from the annual licensure process and are therefore not included in this report. The Commission maintains a detailed inventory of all licensed beds and bassinets in Maryland's acute general hospitals, which is available upon request. The Report also summarizes data on the capacity of acute care hospital services, including the emergency department, surgical services and obstetric services.

Licensed Acute Care Hospital Beds in Maryland: FY 2008

Table 1 shows the licensed acute care bed capacity for each acute care hospital, by service, effective July 1, 2007. The calculation of licensed beds for FY 2008, based on each hospital's average daily census from April 1, 2006 through March 31, 2007, results in a total of 10,681 licensed acute care hospital beds in Maryland. This compares to 10,426 licensed beds in FY 2007, an overall statewide increase of 255 beds from FY 2007 to FY 2008. Table 2 shows the nine-year trend in licensed acute care beds by hospital, beginning with the year just prior to implementation of the licensure process.

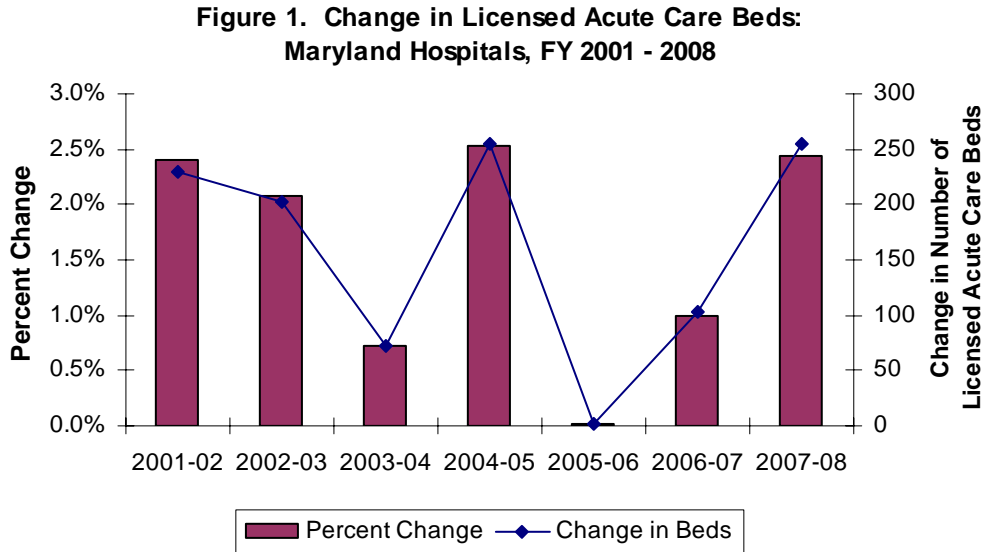

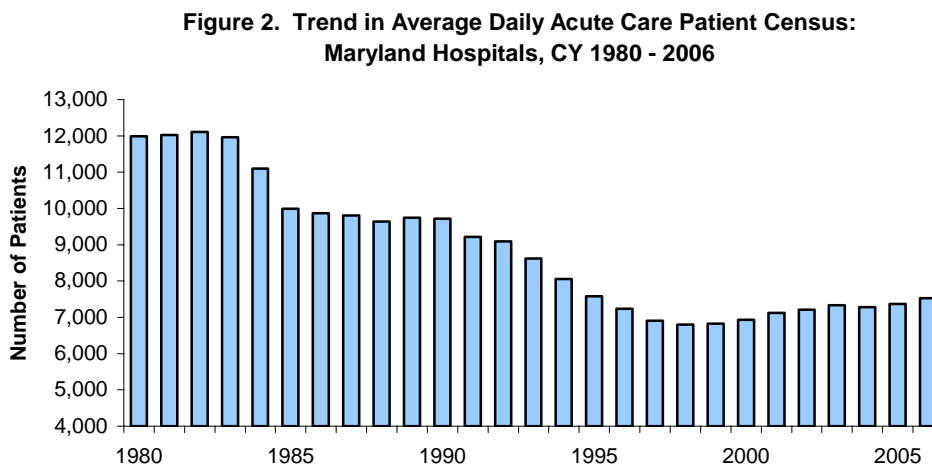

Figure 1 shows both the change in the number of licensed beds over the last six years and the change as a percentage, illustrating the relative size of the increases since implementation of the dynamic licensure process.



While there have been recent increases experienced in average daily census, hospital utilization overall has declined over the past two decades. Figure 2 shows the recent trend of increasing utilization in the context of the long term decline in hospital utilization, as measured by average daily census.

Table 3 shows the changes in total licensed beds from a regional perspective. All five Maryland regions reflect an overall increase in bed capacity, although 14 hospitals experienced a decline in calculated licensed beds. Thirty-three (33) hospitals increased their licensed bed capacity and two (2) hospitals showed no change. All hospitals in Montgomery County increased their licensed bed capacity.

Table 4 shows the trend in the number of licensed beds by major clinical service. The majority of the increase in licensed beds over the last six years has occurred in the MSGA bed category.

Table 5 shows the FY 2008 inventory of critical care beds, which are a subset of medical-surgical beds. Critical care beds comprise 10.8% of the state's licensed MSGA beds, ranging from just over 7% in Western Maryland to 13% of licensed MSGA beds in Montgomery County.

Table 7 shows the trend in licensed acute care beds among hospitals that are part of a multi-hospital system and hospitals that are independent. The twenty-three Maryland hospitals in the eight multi-hospital systems include 49% of the hospitals and 57% of the licensed acute care beds in the state. For the fourth year in a row, more growth occurred in the non-system hospitals than in the system hospitals. Since FY 2001, the number of licensed acute care beds in non-system hospitals has grown by 13.6%, compared with a 10.3% increase in the system hospital licensed acute care beds.

Total Available Acute Care Bed Capacity

The Commission surveys hospitals for the total number of acute care beds they could physically accommodate, if necessary. Available acute care capacity is defined as the total number of acute inpatient beds that are available for use, or that could be physically set up in space appropriate for licensed acute inpatient care, as admission might warrant. It is a physical count of beds based on the available headwalls, measuring the maximum operating capacity under normal, non-emergency circumstances, rather than a measure of staffing capacity.

This survey shows that acute care bed capacity still exists that is neither licensed nor used. This additional available acute care capacity, which could be available to accommodate short term growth in demand and, if necessary, major emergencies and disasters, has been estimated through the Commission's July 1, 2007 survey at 849 beds. The results of this survey are shown in Table 8.¹

¹ This is the fourth year of the voluntary survey. The data are self reported and not verified by the Commission. To the extent possible, the Commission is verifying hospital total available capacity on a case by case basis, primarily as part of the review of hospital expansion, renovation, and replacement projects submitted under the Certificate of Need program.

Note: Total available physical capacity is defined as the total number of acute inpatient beds that are available for use, including those that could be physically set up in space appropriate for licensed acute inpatient care as admissions might warrant. This should be a count of potentially available physical bed capacity rather than a measure of staffing capacity or a reflection of current use of patient care rooms. This is determined by the number of headwalls and/or gas lines that could be made available for inpatient use, without renovations. Rooms with two headwalls/gas lines should be counted as having capacity for two beds, and rooms with one headwall/gases should be counted as having capacity for one bed, regardless of their current use. It does not include space currently used for non-acute or special hospital beds.

Emergency Department Treatment Capacity

Maryland has 46 emergency departments located in Acute Care Hospitals and additional emergency treatment spaces at two freestanding centers that provide emergency services. Bowie Health Center, located in Prince George's County, has 21 treatment spaces allocated to emergency care. Bowie is not open 24 hours a day, but unlike urgent care centers in Maryland, the Bowie Health Center accepts ambulances. The Shady Grove Emergency Center at Germantown in Montgomery County is a freestanding facility that operates as a 24 hour emergency center but does not have inpatient beds. Patients requiring inpatient care are transported to area hospitals.

Table 9 shows the change in emergency department/center treatment capacity from a regional perspective. Twelve (12) emergency departments increased capacity and the Shady Grove Emergency Center at Germantown, a freestanding facility, opened and added 21 spaces to emergency treatment capacity in Montgomery County. Five emergency departments showed a decline in the number of treatment spaces from 2006 to 2007. Table 10 summarizes the Commission's supplemental survey of emergency department treatment capacity by Hospital and jurisdiction/ region.

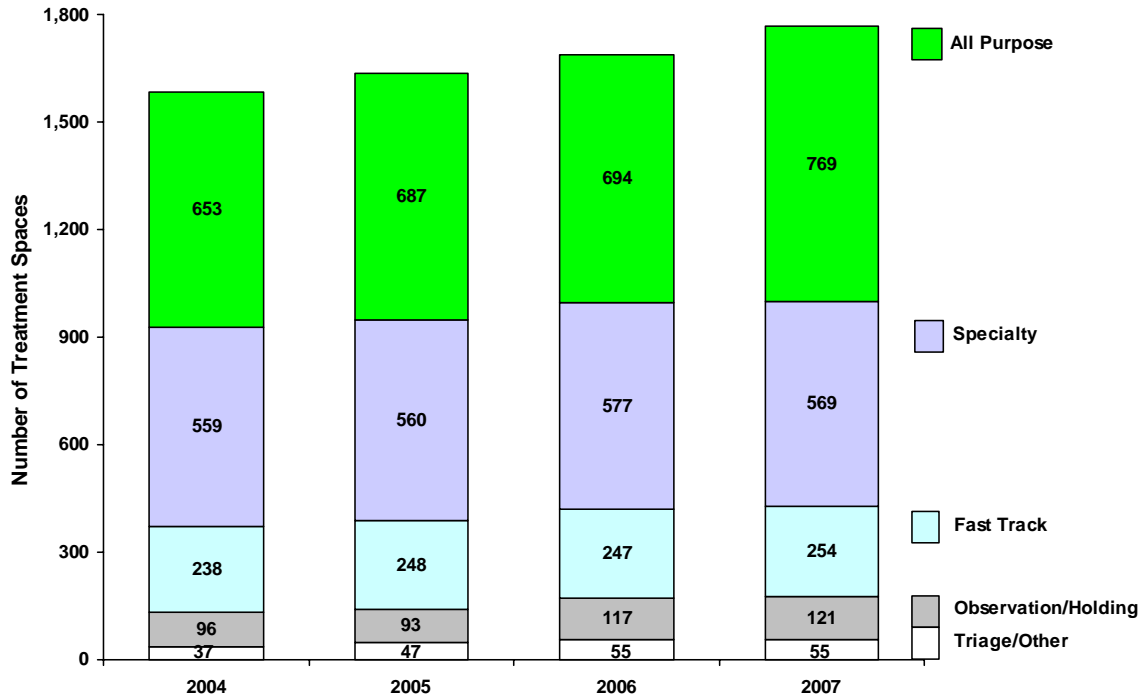

Surgical Services Capacity

“Hospital surgical capacity” refers to the number of operating and procedure rooms available for surgery as of June 1, 2007. Table 12 displays the inventory of sterile operating rooms, by room type, excluding dedicated cesarean section rooms. Table 13 profiles the inventory of dedicated cesarean section operating rooms and procedure rooms. Procedure rooms are rooms used for endoscopy, cystoscopy, or other minor procedures and many are not sterile rooms, and thus, are only appropriately used for “closed” procedures that do not involve surgical incisions.
